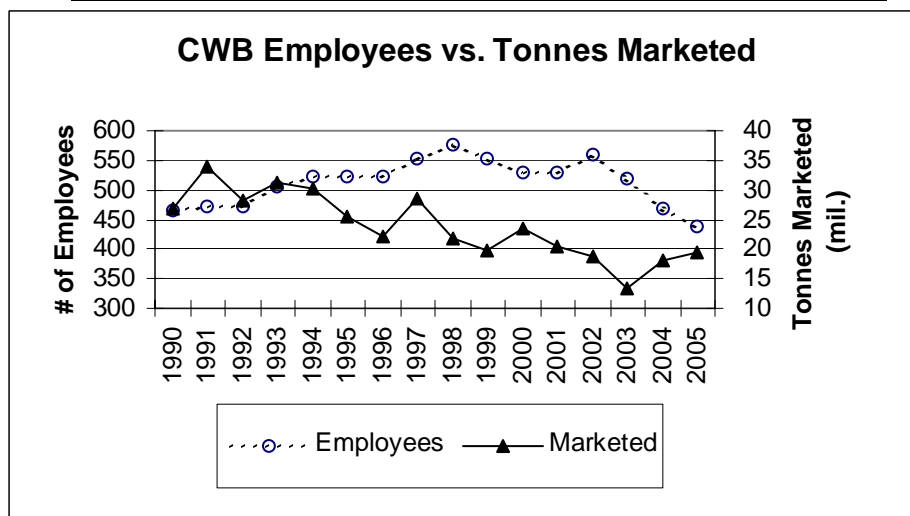


CWB Employees and Tonnes Marketed

September 2006

- An eight-month long corporate review was announced in December 2002 with the main focus aiming at providing farmers with better service through the consolidation of related activities. Announced in February 2004, the results of this consolidation were to include a reduction in positions of about 135 employees by July 2004, through a hiring freeze, outsourcing and job cuts.
- In 2005, the CWB got a little closer to its 2004 commitments and effectively lowered their persons per million tonnes from 26 to 23.
